Welcome to Calington Castle, a place where you journey into light as answers come alive in the way of storybook characters that are acted out in answers you've been searching for. Each book stands on its own and is designed to be a page-turner.

Prince Liam goes on a quest for a truth that will deliver his father from a spell. He battles the thoughts inside his mind like dragons until all becomes resolved. As Prince Liam makes discoveries about himself, you grow along with his character and uncover mysteries that are hidden under the guise of reality, as all that's confusing to him is removed. He discovers how to make better choices for his life.

In book 1 of the series, you not only fall in love with the characters by identifying with them, but the truth itself. Yet everything becomes subject to question in this series as in book 2, "How a marriage really impacts a community and what is deemed as truth becomes tested to see what holds true." This series expands from the medieval era to an American Indian genre. New characters are introduced progressively as the map of The Calington Castle provinces becomes filled throughout each story.

In book 3, cultural clashes and wars are fought to preserve some provinces and traditions, while other conflicts arise through spirituality and religion. These ideas are further examined in book 4 as the big question arises, "Should the gods fight it out through the reasoning of light of the highest truth, or should men continue to allow themselves to be used as physical pawns in spiritual wars?"

Book 5 is written by Prince Liam's younger brother, Edward, in a personal journal of what he learns by watching everything around him come into focus. He's taken note of writing about everything as he sorts through his thoughts from what he faces during their travels. He has personal great awakenings. The book includes many meditations and poetry as the journey continues, while spirits battle for his mind.

In book 6, two brave souls face many perils as they travel to a forgotten place and discover they must overcome their handicaps along the way. Or were they a part of the plan all along? Many new characters spice the story colorfully with strange encounters with mythical beings while traveling through a desert, great forests, and a strange land where the healing serum must be found.

Board the "Hope it Floats" in book 7 and travel the ocean coast. There are many pleasant surprises in book seven, all in the way of more adventurous stories and characters. Who knows? Maybe the door to all evil can finally be closed and peace restored to mankind.

Book 8 is better than a fountain of youth. It's a very deep read that takes a look at the riddle to understanding all of life's mysteries which translates into eternity, penned out by the character of a monsignor, who leaves instructions on how to do battle with any addiction in a practical way, along with other meditations for those who want to take a look at life on a more serious note. A bonus play is included.

In book 9, "What is it in life that produces a true friend?" King Liam is old now and desires to pass the baton of wisdom to his grandson on what it means to be a true friend. After an incident occurs in his grandson's life, he finds himself betrayed by being shoved to the ground by someone who at first seemed like a friend. So he goes to his grandfather for answers. Circumstances arise

where young Ronan is suddenly whisked away. Will everything that he's been taught hold true? Is love a bond to truth that will never fail?

Wisdom has dictated that due to our changing times with invasions on every side, "The Solution," Calington Castle book 10 in the series, had to be newly added. It reveals the nature of our real enemy within all of our minds.

In a fun and relevant way, RA Feller has taken on the challenges of what it means to be fully alive and free within his adventure series. In the Calington Castle 10 book series, all are well crafted as novels that hold onto what is wise. Over forty years in the making, while journeying through life, many problems are faced, like stones overturned to reveal how to handle what lurks beneath them. Poor decisions are like shadows without the truth of light for direction. The stories are written to hold true for all times. You'll not walk away without becoming wiser.
